

Middle School Social Studies Teacher Gr. 6 - 8 (Laupahoehoe)

Laupahoehoe Community Public Charter School is seeking teacher applicants for Middle School Social Studies for the 2018-2019 school year.

Length of Assignment: 10 Months

Primary Purpose:

To create a flexible program and class environment favorable to learning and personal growth; to establish effective rapport with students; to motivate students to develop skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation in middle school social studies education in accordance with each student's ability; to establish good relationships with parents and other staff members.

Teacher will be expected to teach 3 core social studies classes and 2 electives. Electives will be Hawaiian Language & Hawaiian Culture

1.) Responsibilities

- A. Instructs student citizenship and basic subject matter.
- B. Develops lesson plans and instructional materials and provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of each student.
- C. Uses a variety of instructional strategies, such as inquiry, group discussion, lecture, project based learning, etc..
- D. Translates lesson plans into learning experiences so as to best utilize the available time for instruction.
- E. Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
- F. Evaluates students' academic and social growth, keeps accurate, appropriate records, and prepares progress reports and report cards.
- G. Communicates with parents through conferences and other means to discuss students' progress and interpret the school program.
- H. Identifies student needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health, attitude and learning problems.
- I. Creates an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, bulletin boards and interest centers.
- J. Maintains professional competence through in-service education activities provided by professional growth activities.
- K. Participates cooperatively with the director to develop the method by which the teacher will be evaluated in conformance with guidelines.
- L. Selects and requisitions books and instructional aides; maintains required inventory records.
- M. Supervises students in out-of-classroom activities during the school day and while on excursions.
- N. Administers group and individual standardized test in accordance with state testing program.
- O. Participates in curriculum development programs as required.
- P. Participates in faculty committees and the sponsorship of student activities and school events.

- b. Hawaii State teaching license in Social studies/Hawaiian studies, Middle 6-8
- c. Experience
- d. Highly Qualified Teacher Status in the State of Hawaii preferred
