Laupahoehoe Community Public Charter School is seeking 2 Pre-K Teachers to fill our Special Education Pre-Kindergarten and our General Education Pre-Kindergarten classes. We are currently recruiting interested, qualified applicants. If you meet the qualifications listed below, please send us your resume and cover letter as soon as possible. Deadline to submit application is 6/15/18.

(1) The charter school principal/director at the designated sites shall be responsible to hire the most qualified and experienced teaching staff to provide high quality early learning instructional experiences for the students and families that shall be served;

(2) The charter school Pre-K Teacher shall meet the minimal DOE teacher qualifications criteria. The charter school prekindergarten teacher shall have:

(A) A Bachelor's degree in education or early childhood education; and/or

(B) Satisfactory or passing score on the PRAXIS Performance Assessment for Teachers;

(C) Licensure in early childhood education through one of the following options:

(i) Fifteen(15) hours of pedagogy coursework from a state approved teacher program in early childhood education; or

(ii) Twelve (12) hours of pedagogy in coursework from a state approved teacher educational program in early childhood and a passing score on the Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) in early childhood education; and

(D) Three years of industry experience in early childhood education.

(E) Hawaii Teacher Standards Board License (HTSB)

Teacher salary and benefits are determined by the most recent collective bargaining agreement between the Department of Education and the Hawaii State Teacher Association using a modified salary range step schedule that recognizes teaching experience.
